**The first international conference for wombtwin survivors. London. England,  
June 21<sup>st</sup> 2008**

This conference is entitled: **"From theory to therapy"**. There will be a presentation by me, Althea Hayton, about the various physical indicators of a twin lost in pregnancy. A talk on pre-birth psychology will follow from Dr John Rowan, a distinguished expert on prenatal psychotherapy. Finally, there will be a chance to learn how we can begin to develop new forms of therapy for wombtwin survivors, from Nick Owen who is a psychotherapist and a wombtwin survivor.

This will be the first international conference **ever** to be held on this subject. It will be a rare opportunity for everyone to learn more about a common occurrence in pregnancy that has been largely ignored - until very recently.
